ADJUSTING YOUR AUTO-FILL

Auto-fills are a great convenience, but they can also be a source of frustration. We hope that the information below will help you. It is important to know these things about your auto-fill:

1. Your auto-fill will need to be adjusted each year when you turn on your sprinkler system;
2. You may need to readjust the auto-fill throughout the summer. Auto-fills can get knocked out of adjustment when you remove your skimmer mat for cleaning; and
3. Adjusting your auto-fill is quite simple.

You will need a pair of pliers or a small socket wrench that fits the bolt that holds the long float arm attached to the water control arm. The water control arm is less than an inch long and sticks out of the bottom of the nozzle. When it moves backwards, it allows water to enter the nozzle. When it moves forward, it cuts off the water supply. Here is how you adjust it:

1. Grab the float arm between the float and the attachment point where the bolt is located.
2. Take the pliers and loosen the bolt.
3. Pull forward on the float (away from the bolt) so that the water control arm pulls forward.
4. Hold the float arm so that the bottom 1/3 is below the water line at the desired height.
5. Keep pulling out on the float to hold the water control arm in place and tighten the nut.
6. Move the arm up and down to make sure it shuts off and turns on at the appropriate level.
7. Stand back and admire your work.
